Amateur Broadcaster Restricted
Washington.—Under revised regulations governing amateur radio station operations, just issued by the commerce department, amateurs must cease using the wave lengths band between 105 and 110 meters. This section of ether capacity is being taken up by commercial and governmental stations. Amateurs who operate with the spark set which the department classifies as a source of much interference, are instructed to use only the wave length band between 170 and 180 meters until such time as they have installed a transmission system productive of less trouble to other radio communication.
