

## MANTI BOY IS LICENSED AS RADIO OPERATOR

Harold E. Christensen son of Atty and Mrs George Christensen, has received word from the Radio Inspector at San Francisco that he has successfully passed the Amateur Radio Examination, and has been officially licensed with the call GARU.

Mr. Christensen is the first amateur in Sanpete County, and one of the few in the state to be so licensed.

He has been interested in Radio for over 3 years, but has only had his station in operation for about a year and a half.

Amateurs have been heard from Wisconsin, Illinois, Ohio, Dakota, Colorado, New Mexico, and Arizona, as well as all the Inter-Mountain and Pacific Coast states. Press and time reports from Commercial stations are regularly copied, as are press reports from the Desert News station in Salt Lake. Communication is carried on with several sets of amateurs in Sanpete County while Telephone Conversation between Avalon and Los Angeles, and Amateurs mobile and phone furnish considerable amusement to visitors.

Harold has dismantled his apparatus now to take it with him when they move to Price.

Two other Manti boys, Lucian Sears and Owen Thygerson are experimenting with wireless but have not as yet reached the degree of perfection in their studies or in their plants as that attained by young Christensen.
